

PRIVACY POLICY

PHCC OF ARIZONA is committed to protecting your privacy. That is why we have adopted this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy is intended to describe how your personal information is processed and used, and we will make every effort to ensure that our activities keep within the spirit of this Privacy Policy. Please note that by visiting and using azneca.org or arizonaneca.org, you are accepting the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

Collected Information and Its Use

Every computer connected to the Internet is provided with a domain name and an IP Address (e.g. 200.196.27.189). When a visitor requests a page from within the PHCC OF ARIZONA website, our Web Server automatically identifies and logs these requests. This information reveals nothing personal about you. The only information that we automatically gather and log is as follows:

- The IP Address of the Site that may have referred you.
- Your IP Address
- The Web Page that you may have linked to us from, if any.
- The Product Identifier for Version and Make of Browser (e.g. Internet Explorer 4.5)
- The Operating System platform that you may be running (e.g. Macintosh or Windows)

The practice of collecting this data has been generally standardized by virtually every Web Server on the Internet today.

The purpose for collecting this information is to examine visitor traffic, so that we can ensure maximum compatibility for the various Browsers and Operating Systems that visit our site and enhance our exposure on the Internet.

Cookies

The PHCC OF ARIZONA website DOES NOT utilize cookies.

Spam and Third Party

We maintain a strict "No Spam" policy that means we do not intend to sell, rent, or otherwise give your e-mail address to a third-party, without your consent.

In addition, PHCC OF ARIZONA will not send you e-mail that you have not agreed to receive. If you are a member of our Mailing List, you may be contacted periodically with meeting or event announcements and newsletters. You have the option of "Unsubscribing" from our Mailing List at any time, thereby disabling any further such e-mail communication from being sent to you.

Disclosure Exceptions

PHCC OF ARIZONA will disclose your personal information or any of its logs file information when required by law or in the good-faith belief that such actions are necessary to:

- Conform to the edicts of the law or comply with a legal process served on PHCC OF ARIZONA.
- Protect and defend the rights or property of PHCC OF ARIZONA, or visitors of PHCC OF ARIZONA.
- Identify persons who may be violating the law, the legal notice, or the rights of third parties.
- Cooperate with the investigations of purported unlawful activities.

PHCC OF ARIZONA uses reasonable precautions to keep the information disclosed to us secure. We are not responsible for any breach of security or for any actions of any third parties that receive the information. PHCC OF ARIZONA also provides "links" to a wide variety of other web sites on the Internet. We are not responsible for their Privacy Policies or how those web sites manage information about their users.
